Out on the Streets Again

This month we were blessed to be able to minister to people in parking lots in SC and MS; on the street in Forest City, NC; door to door in Ellenboro, NC; at the St. Patrick's Day celebration in Savannah, GA; and at the Cherry Blossom Festival in Macon, GA. We passed out tracts, but never had the liberty to preach in Forest City. Down the road, in Ellenboro, we had some very good witnesses as we went door to door.

In Savannah the Lord used six street preachers plus Pastor Dale Mathis to give 500,000+ people the gospel message. I had the chance to spend time with Alicia, Scott, Mark, Henry and Ray down by the river as I explained that repentance is more than saying I'm sorry. Ray has promised to call me to talk some more. (Acts 17:32)

Often times you have to reach out and "touch" the lost before you will be given an ear for the gospel. This was the case with Jennifer in SC; Neal, the security guard, in Macon, and Scott in MS. They each had the need to pour out their troubled lives for me to hear, then I told them of the one that can bind up the broken heart and save there souls from hell. Also in Macon we were used of the Lord, along with several friends, to preach the gospel of peace to thousands at the Cherry Blossom Festival.

We praise God that we can work for him here in the States while we are preparing to go to New Zealand. However, we are all eager and long to be working for our Saviour on the streets and in the neighborhoods of New Zealand. Please pray with us for the souls in New Zealand. We ask him on a regular basis that he would prepare the hearts of the kiwis now, that they would be ready to hear and receive the Word (Mark 4:20).
