Our landlord Jackie was coming around every day for weeks and then her husband's mother was diagnosed with cancer and she stopped coming. We have been able to purchase 20 chairs and have begun holding Sunday services in our sleep-out which has a large room. We have many curious people that have walked by the open doors to hear the praise and preaching. Richard and Angela that we bought a bunk bed from have indicated they want to know more about our Jesus because the RC Jesus has not satisfied them.
